
### **Species**

Blue marlin, blue marlin and blue marlin! Occasionally a white marlin and maybe a spearfish. Wahoo is always around. And depending of their presence, big yellowfin and/or bigeye tuna. April, May and June are by far the best months to catch multiple marlin a day. In 2015, participants in The PENN Challenge caught 68 blue marlin. Heaviest marlin was estimated 900+ lbs.

### The tournament setup

We fish five days. Teams alternate boats daily. We can host 15 - 20 boats in the tournament.

Amongst these boats are the Mindelo top boats, La Onda Andromeda (Olaf Grimkowski), La Onda Mila (Marty Bates), Amelia II (Zak Conde), Cal Rei II (Randy Das), Victoria, (Marco Canu), next to the Berno Niebuhr's Happy Hooker, Eric Leblond's Sirategui, Stuart Simpson's Nha Cretcheu and Steve George's Sea Quest.





# **IGFA and Offshore World Championship (OWC)**

The PENN Challenge is an IGFA Fishing Club. We try to fish by IGFA rules as much as possible. The PENN Challenge is also an Qualifying Event to the Offshore World Championship (OWC). The winning team will be invited to participate in the prestigious Offshore World Championship 2018.

### EFSA Netherlands; Open Dutch Championship Big Game Fishing 2017

Part of The PENN Challenge is the EFSA Open Dutch Championship Big Game Fishing 2017 for teams. The championship is open to members of EFSA only.















## Flights and stay

Participants book their own flights and have to make their own reservations. Don Paco Hotel, next to the marina offers PENN Challenge participants a discount on their room rates. So is Las Rochas Residence just outside Mindelo. Further details on request.



### Charity

Since our tournament is a charity tournament, open to all, we don't charge an additional entry fee. We do request all participants to support the charity goals in a financial or material way. Our charity goal in Sao Vicente is the support of the children & teens shelters of ICCA Mindelo. The shelters provides aid to orphans and mistreated or abused children. In 2015 the participants, sponsors and crews raised over € 5.000 for ICCA Mindelo.
