After having the pleasure of organising an EFSA SHORE championship five times, we are delighted to add to our first EFSA Species Championship.

The championship will be held from Neeltje Jans.

Neeltje Jans is approximately 285 hectares in size and is located halfway between the Oosterscheldekering between Schouwen and Noord-Beveland, but nevertheless belongs to the municipality of Veere on Walcheren. Neeltje Jans is the name of the boat that ran aground on the sandbar; it is an old folk name for the patron goddess Nehalennia.

Neeltje Jans used to be a sandbar in the mouth of the Oosterschelde estuary.

Raising the sandbar created the working island, which was used at the time the storm surge barrier was built.



From Neeltje Jans, our reserved boats will take you to the waters around Neeltje Jans.

For this competition, the target species is shark

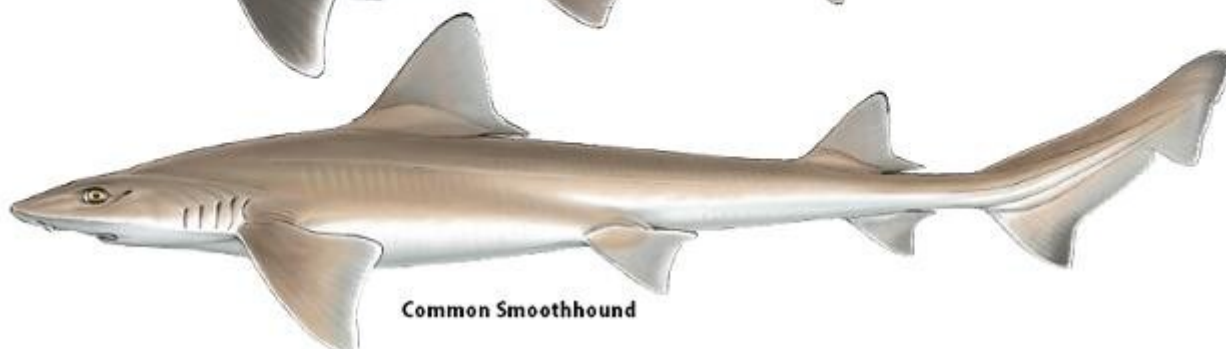
RULES EFSA EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIPS SPECIES

1. Every participant is expected to know and comply with these regulations.
2. In all decisions not provided for in these regulations, the person(s) designated by EFSA Netherlands at that time by the organization will decide.
3. The target of this championship is the Shark. The participant who has achieved the most ranking points at the end of 2 days is the EFSA European Species 2025 champion
4. EFSA Netherlands provides the bait. It is only permitted to use bait provided by the organization. The organization may and can exercise control over this. Rag worm and frozen shrimp (both subject to availability)
5. Competition duration is 3 x 100 minutes.
6. The organization gives the start and end signals.
7. Fishing is not allowed before the starting signal has been given.
8. At the final signal, the shark currently hooked still counts.
9. Fishing is done with 1 fishing rod, with a maximum of 1 hook. A spare rod without a leader is allowed. This must be stored in the cabin or gangway where it will not bother your fellow fishermen. It is not allowed to have a spare trace. When changing a trace, you must immediately store the old trace in the fishing box and/or bag before removing the new trace
10. The shark does not count if it is foul hooked behind the eyes.
11. It is forbidden to get out of the cockpit to untie your rod/line. The skipper will help out should it occur
12. Casting must be done underhand. The picture on the attached page makes it clear in which direction to cast, depending on your position on the boat.
13. Catch and release is mandatory. (This also applies to by-catch such as dab, flounder, sea bass, sole, etc.)
14. All sharks are measured by the organization and the help of the fisherman. Each shark caught is rewarded with 10 points for a shark up to 50 cm- 20 points for a shark from 51 to 100cm and 30 points for all sharks above 101cms. There is also an additional 5 points per caught shark.
15. Shark with 2 hooks from 2 participants in the mouth does not count. This must be put back immediately after unhooking. Only then may fishing resume.
16. If it turns out that 2 participants have achieved the same number of points per period, the participant with the highest number of sharks will take precedence in the period rankings. If this is also the same, both participants will receive the same number of points in the period rankings.
17. After the competition the awards ceremony will take place, how what and where follows.
18. EFSA stands for Fair Play. Unsportsmanlike and/or intimidating behavior may result in disqualification.
19. Let's all make it a successful day!

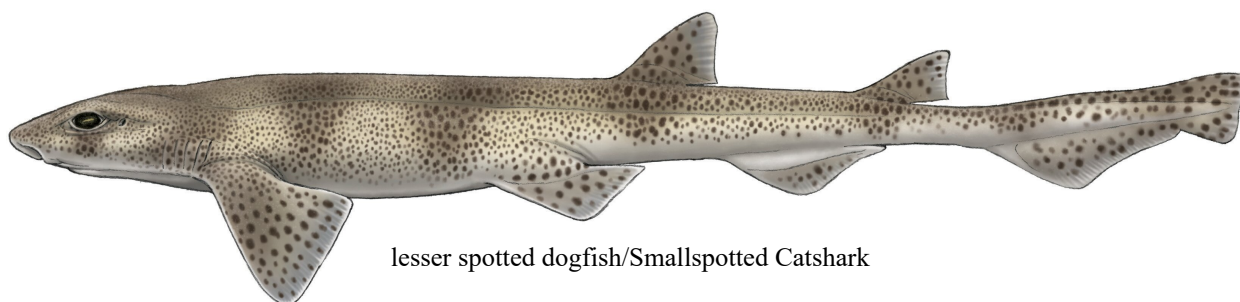
Expected species to be caught



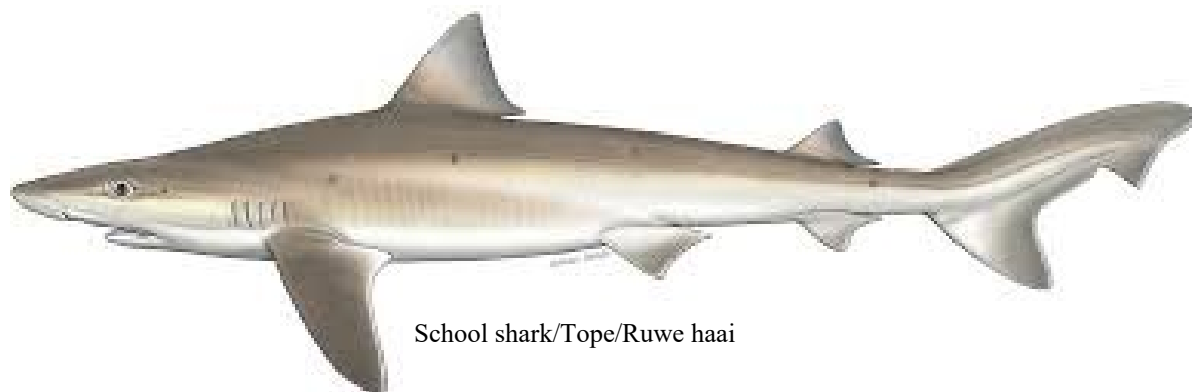
Starry Smoothhound

Shark fishing

Shark fishing in the Netherlands is seasonal. Depending on sea water temperatures, shark fishing starts around mid-May and ends in mid-October. The most commonly caught North Sea Shark is the Spotted Smooth Shark.

If Enzo Knol on board the Sea Eagle can catch one, you should surely be able to too! Of course, our expert and helpful skippers are ready to help you. How wonderful it is to catch a Shark on the North Sea. By the way, we put all caught Sharks back in the water, Catch and Release!

The spotted smooth shark

The Spotted Smooth Shark, as also shown in the video with Enzo Knol, shot at our location at De Zeearend I, is truly a sport fish. The smallest ever caught by us was 16 cm, meaning the Shark was just born. 123 cm was the biggest and that really gave a nice fight! This Shark can grow up to 160 cm, so these big guys also swim around the spots we fish specifically for Sharks.

Inexperienced angler?

Even at the Sharks, you need not worry as an inexperienced angler. Thanks to the good guidance of our Skippers and the right quality of our rods and lines combined with super bait, you can join us with family, friends and the kids for a successful adventure.

By the way, there are other species of Sharks that we catch with some regularity. The Smooth Shark, Rough Shark and the Dogfish. However, these species are a lot more difficult to catch, which is why we mainly fish for the Spotted Smooth Shark. On request, we can of course make an exception.

The Nautilus I is a Blyth WorkCat catamaran , 11x 5 metres, 2 reliable 170hp Yanmar diesels, good for a cruising speed of 15 knots.

She is equipped with 4x chartplotters, 2x VHF radio, 2x radar, 2x fish finders / sonar, and auto-pilot.

This super stable fishing platform is a joy to sail and fish with, and when we talk about a spacious fishing deck . they don't come much roomier than this!

Boy Kotter, the Nautilus II.

The Nautilus II, 12x4 metres, 2 reliable V12 850hp Cat diesels, twin screw driven, good for a cruising speed of over 17 knots. And, which is unique, the Nautilus II is fishable all around thanks to the wraparound, wide gunwale!

She is equipped with 2x chartplotters, 2x marine telephone, ais, radar and 2x fish finder / sonar.

As a matter of course, both vessels are equipped with the necessary rescue equipment such as rafts, vests, emergency fireworks, etc.

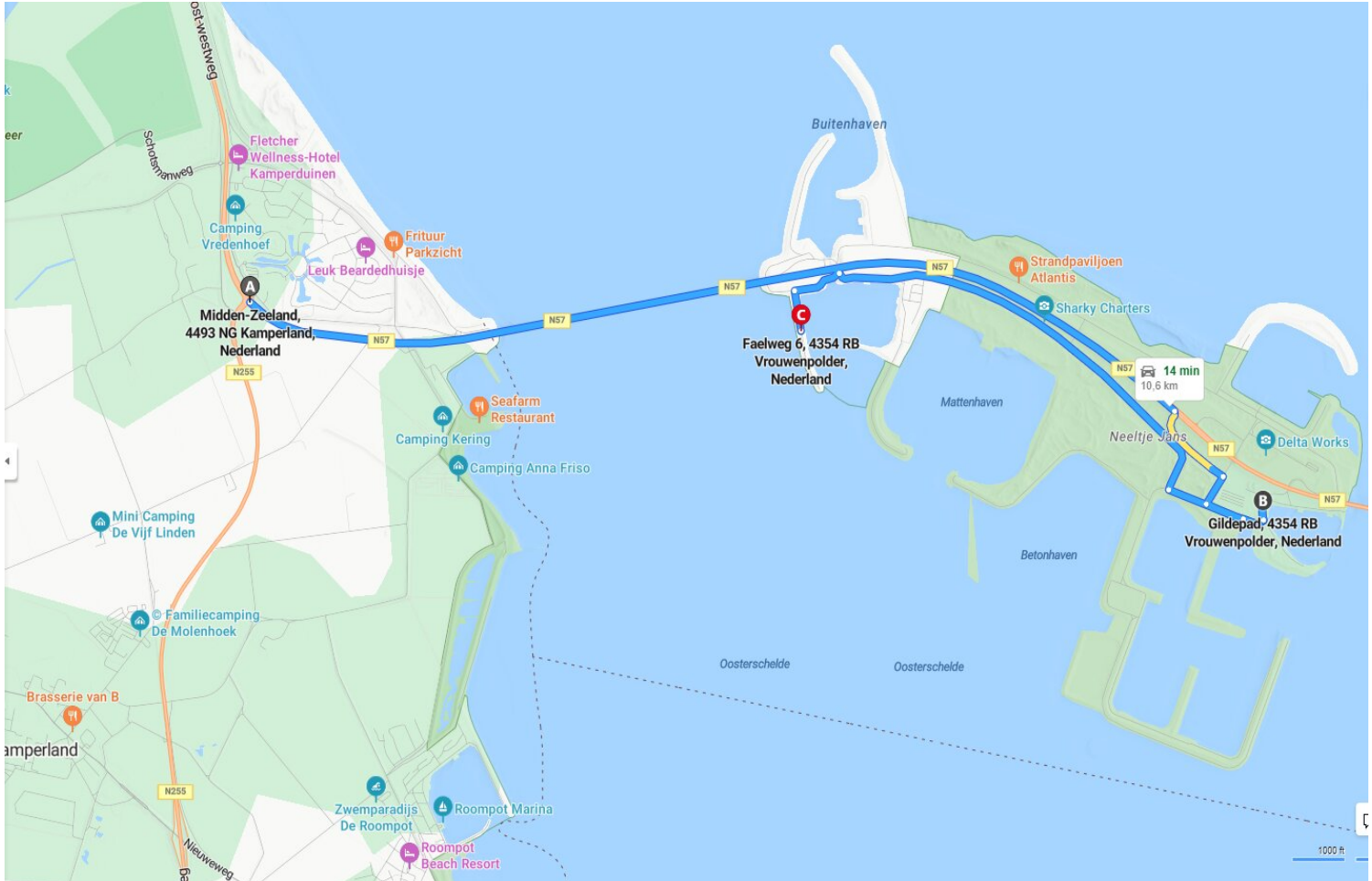

As a working island, Neeltje Jans is part of the Eastern Scheldt storm surge barrier.

After the completion of the Delta Works, an information and amusement park was opened on Neeltje Jans.

The information centre features an exhibition about the Delta Works with (visual) information.

Neeltje Jans is about 285 hectares and is located halfway between Schouwen and Noord-Beveland, but nevertheless belongs to the municipality of Veere on Walcheren.

Neeltje Jans is the name of the boat that ran aground on the sandbar; it is an old folk name for the patron goddess Nehalennia.

Neeltje Jans used to be a sandbar in the mouth of the Oosterschelde estuary.

Raising the sandbar created the working island, which was used at the time the storm surge barrier was built.

When the work was completed in 1986, Natuurmonumenten and Het Zeeuwse Landschap bought the island and converted it into a nature reserve that is part of Oosterschelde National Park.

A remaining pillar can be found near the island.

This 66th pillar was made around 1980 along with the other pillars, in case one of the others proved to be faulty, but was never put into use.

Since then, the pillar has stood lonely in its dock.

A climbing centre was located on the pillar, but it is now closed.

On the island is a depot with stones in many sizes for emergencies.

When a dam near Maastricht was damaged in January 2024, a large number of trucks with stones were brought from Neeltje Jans to Limburg to fill the hole.

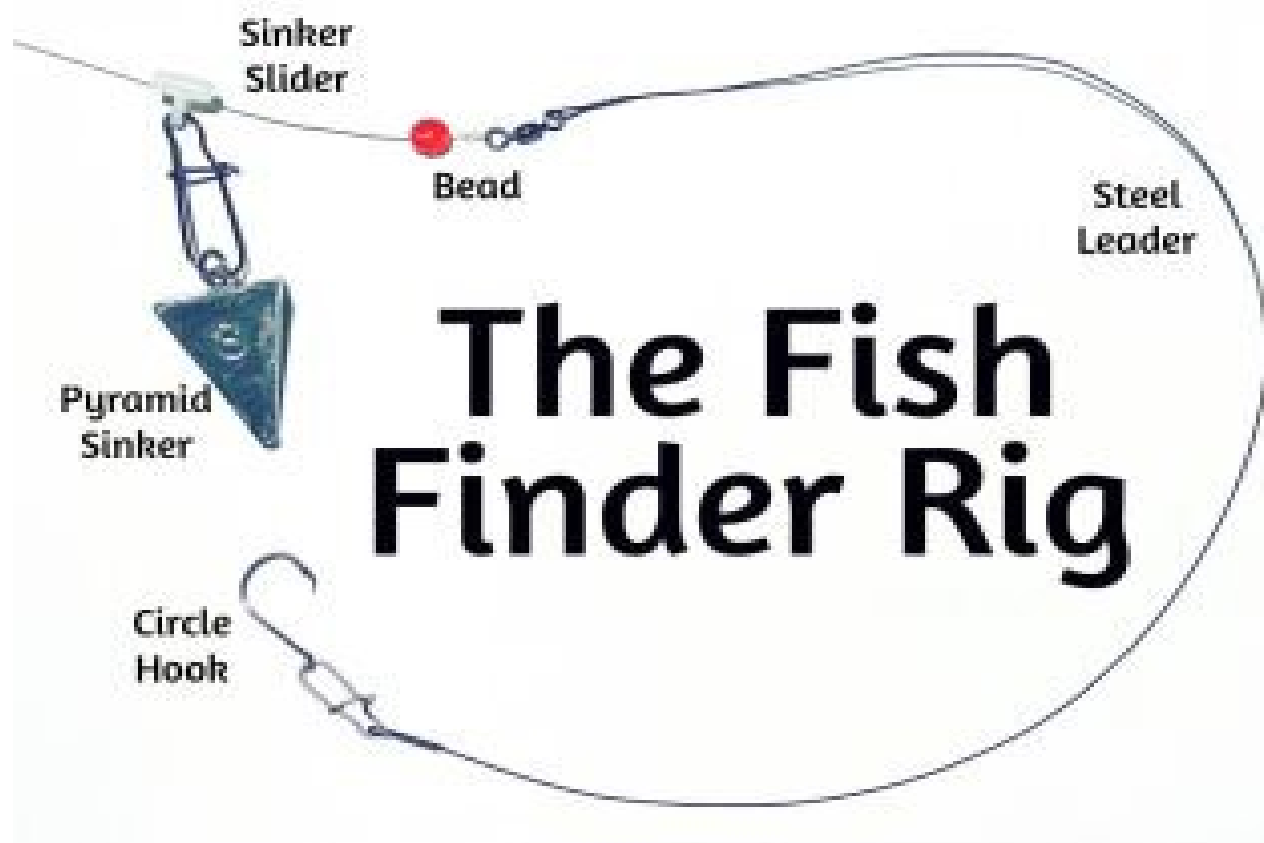
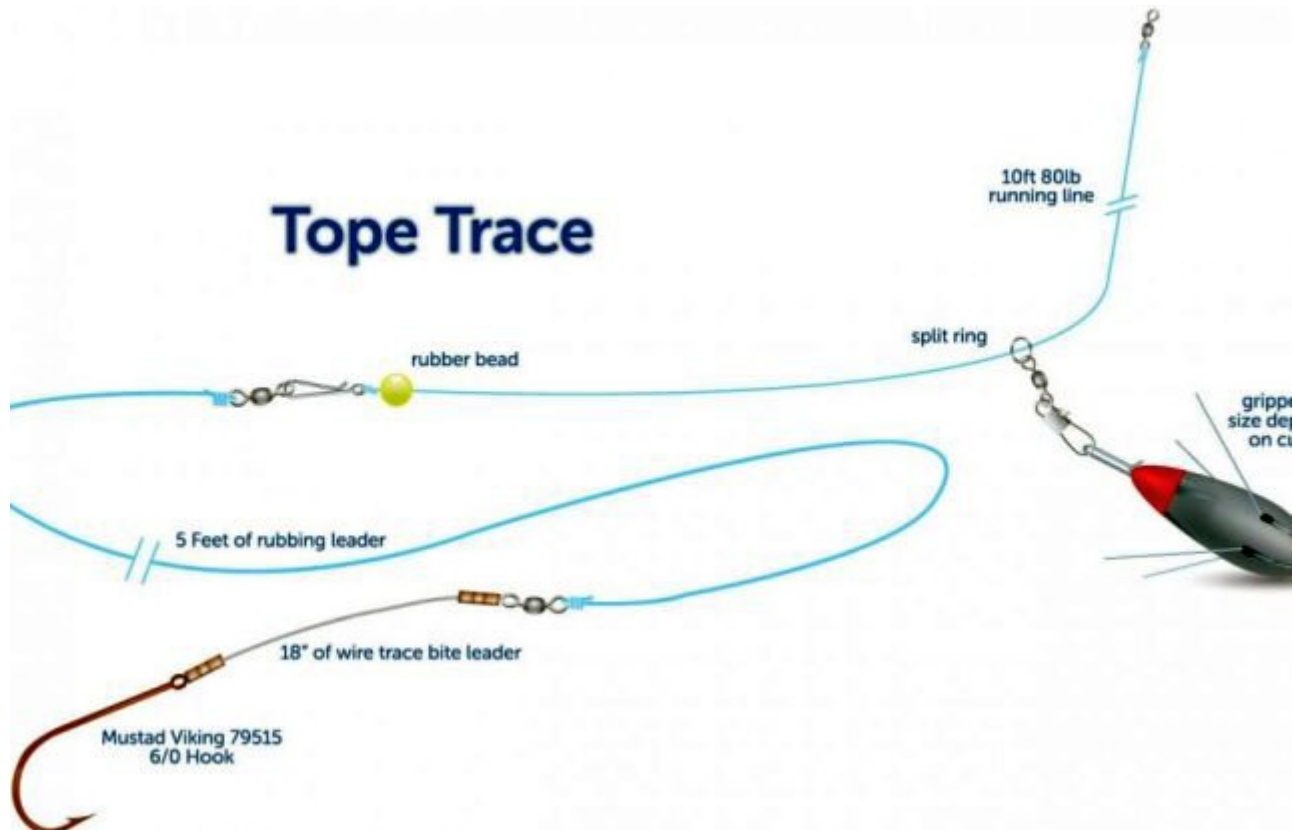
Wind turbines have been located on Neeltje Jans since 1991.

The initial eight smaller turbines have since been replaced by two wind farms of four turbines each.

Wind farm Bouwdokken forms the additional third wind farm.

The radar tower De Lange Neel has stood on the island since 2016. On 5 July 2015, the second stage of the Tour de France ended at Neeltje Jans.
